The Practical Nursing Program at Midlands Technical College strives to provide quality educational programs through continuous program assessment. The entry level practical nurse performs the essential competencies to care for patients with commonly occurring health problems with predicable outcomes. Nursing Faculty review the program outcomes on a regular basis to improve student learning outcomes.

NCLEX-PN Pass Rates: The pass rates are based on first time candidates of the National Council of State Boards of Nursing Licensing Exam (NCLEX). The time period is between Jan 01 and December 31 of the reported year. The goal of the nursing faculty is for first time takers of the NCLEX to be in compliance with more than 5% below the annual national pass rate.

Program Completion Rates: The goal of the nursing faculty is for at least 55% of the MTC graduates of the PN Program to graduate within 150% of the program length. This equates to 5 semesters once they enter the program.
